- 3.) When any Ceremonial Officer addresses you, please wait until the Warden instructs you to answer. Then speak loudly and clearly so all in the Council chamber can hear you.
- 4.) If you are questioned by any Ceremonial Officer, wait until instructed to answer by the Warden, then please respond with "Yes, Sir" or "No, Sir"
- 5.) Relax and enjoy the ceremony.
