RULES FOR WEARING THE THIRD DEGREE DRESS JEWEL

- 1. The jewel is restricted to Third and Fourth Degree members.
- 2. It is to be worn on the left breast pocket of a coat (Tux Business Suit Sport Coat)
- 3. Members who hold or who have held an office for which a miniature past or former office jewel has been issued can wear the miniature with the Third Degree jewel side by side.
- 4. It is preferable that members not wear the Third Degree jewel and the name identification badge at the same time. If he chooses to do so, however, the jewel should be worn beneath the badge.
- 5. When the Third Degree member jewel is worn, the customary lapel pin (the emblem of the Order) may also be worn.
- 6. The jewel may be worn at any formal event where Knights assemble as a group, e.g. Holy Mass, parade, social function, business meeting.
- 7. If a member is entitled to wear more than one miniature jewel, that of the highest office held should be worn closest to the lapel, then the next highest, etc.
- 8. These guidelines shall no doubt be subject to change when the jewel becomes more widely used.
